Please read all General Rules! Events rules will be discussed before the Rodeo Starts!

RANCH RODEO GENERAL RULES

1. All teams members must be at least 18 years of age. An alternate member may be named in case of and emergency. That alternate member must compete in ALL remaining events. Each team member must ride the same horse sustains an injury and the judge approves, a new horse may be brought in.
2. No one can be on more than one team.
3. Each team member must wear a hat (no caps), long sleeve shirt and boots.
4. Each team shall have a designated captain. The captain will be the ONLY team member allowed to address the judge.
5. Only the team that is competing will be allowed in the arena.
6. “All – Around” will be declared by the fastest total time in all events. A no time in any event disqualifies a team from All-Around.
7. All disputes will be settled by the judge(s) only! If any team has a protest or complaint, their captain must address the judge(s) before the next teams time starts.
8. Stock number and working order will be drawn for.
9. Stock numbers will be announced when the first rider crosses line and judge drops flag.
10. Any abuse to any animal will be grounds for disqualification! (Example: dragging while stock is down, excessive choking, whipping horses, etc.)
11. There is a 2-½ minute time limit on all events (excluding penalties).
12. Only two riders may cross herd line at any one time.
13. Riders will not be allowed to lope horses across line into the herd.
14. There will be a 5 seconds penalty added to time for each head of cattle crossing the line other than the designated stock. If 3 or more head of undesignated stock cross the line, that shall constitute a loss of herd and result in a no time.
15. No swapping of ropes between members.
16. Each team member must be ready to enter the arena and be ready to compete in its drawn position.
17. It is each team’s responsibility to check cattle numbers before the rodeo for numbers hard to read, blotched, double numbered, etc...
18. If a cowboy forgets stock number, he should raise his hand to announcers stand and the number will be announced again.
19. If a cowboy drops his rope, then any other team may ropo the animal and proceed without penalty.
20. No tripping or heeling of stock is allowed in any event... either can result in disqualification.
21. NO ROPES SHALL BE LEFT ON HORSES OR SADDLE IF COWBOY DISMOUNTS!!!
22. All teams must participate in all events to be eligible for jackpot.
23. Team must call for their times.
